To the Commissioners of Belmont County, State of Ohio

Ordinance No. 16 Authorizing the Detachment of Real Estate from the Village of Holloway.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Holloway, State of Ohio, Section 1, that the application of Mahlon White and others for the detachment of the following described real estate from the Village of Holloway, Ohio, and added to Flashing Township, Belmont County Ohio.

Copy of Journal Entry April 17, 1950 in the Matter of Detachment of Territory from the Village of Holloway. Resolution Adopted.

Mr. Truesdell moved the adoption of the following Resolution: The Commissioners of the County of Belmont State of Ohio, on this day to hear the petition Mahlon White et al to abate in the detachment of territory in the petition described in the Village of Holloway, Ohio and in open meeting heard all persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition with reference thereto, and being fully advised find that the petition and ordinance of the Village of Holloway, Ohio, contain all the matters required by law that if statements are true, that the territory sought to be detached is within the corporate limits of the Village of Holloway, Ohio, that the petition contains a full description of said territory sought to be detached, that the map of said territory attached to the petition is accurate, that said petition is signed by a majority of adult freeholders, and electors residing on the territory sought to be detached, and that it is right that said petition should be granted.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that the territory described in the petition shall be detached from the Village of Holloway, Ohio, in accordance with the law and that a certified transcript signed by a majority of the Board of all the orders and proceedings of the board relative to the petition and hearing thereon, together with said petition and maps attached thereto and all papers on file relating to said matter be deposited of and with the Village Clerk of Holloway, Ohio, to be recorded in the Boarders Office of Belmont Co. Ohio.
