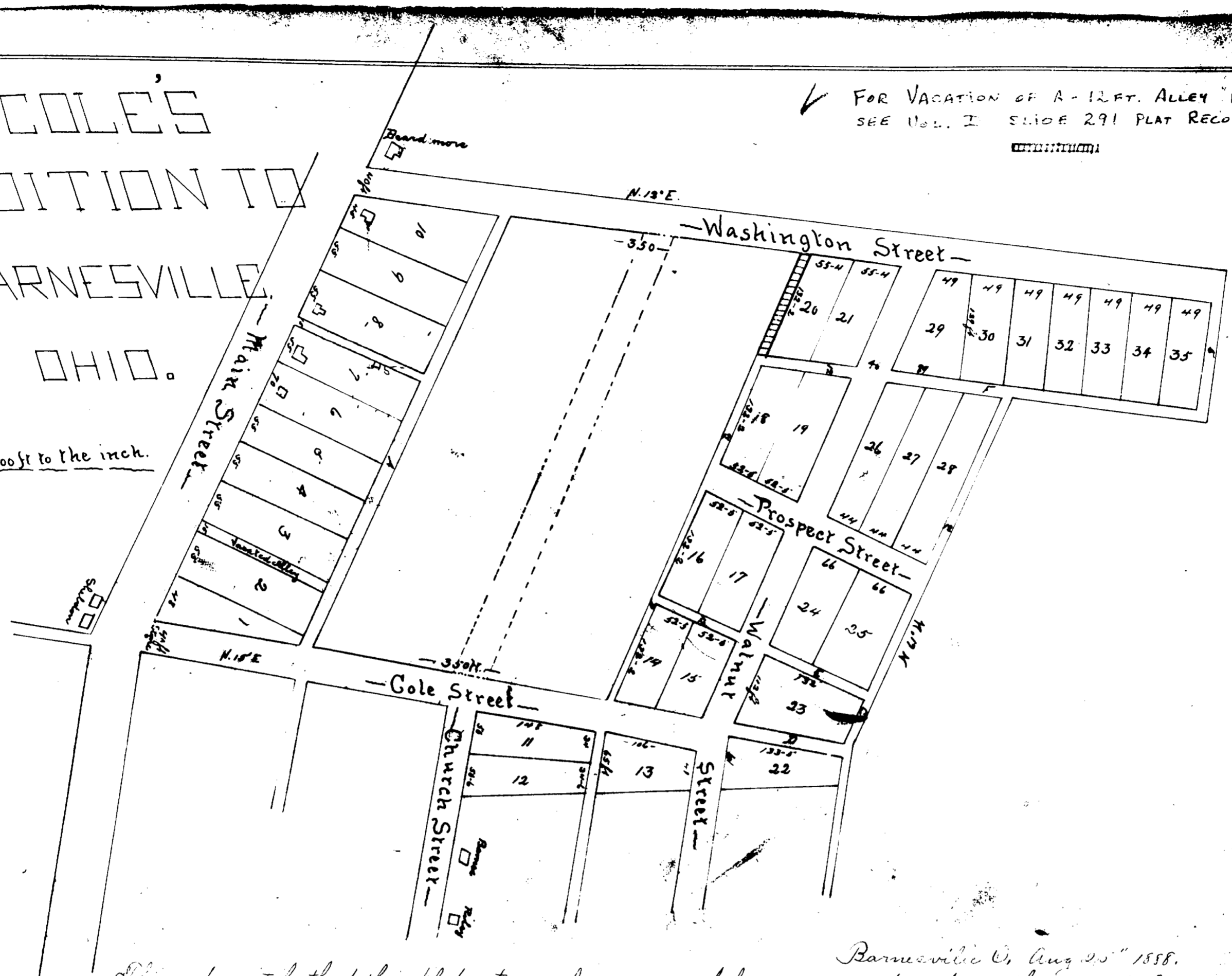


# COLE'S ADDITION TO BARNESVILLE, OHIO.

Barnesville O, Aug 25<sup>th</sup> 1858.

This is to certify that this plat is taken from a careful measurement made on the ground. Commencing for the same at a stone marked on a line with Main St. at the intersection of Cole St. and running  $N 61^{\circ} W$  25 feet to corner of lot 1 of Cole's first addition to Barnesville; thence  $N 10^{\circ} E$  to Alley C. Church and Walnut Sts. also Alley A. B. and C. are laid with west Main St. from the west line of Cole St. (all bearing  $N 61^{\circ} W$ ) and running through to Washington St. Church Walnut, and Alley B. intersect Cole St. from the East St. right angles. Washington St. and Alley C. are parallel. Washington St. intersects Main St. at the N.E. corner of Beardmore land. Prospect St. and Alley E. are parallel and at right angles to Alley B. Alley D. is 15 feet wide and has same bearing as Cole St. Alley G. intersects Main St. at right angles. All 40 ft alleys 12 ft. with exception of Alley D. it being 15 ft. Land composing said plat is part of sec. 24 R. 6 T. Sp. 8. S.W. part of N.E. quarter and shown as part of the Cole Estate.
