Plat of a portion of the Crangle Farm at Pultrney Bottom in Pultrney and Mead Townships (Sciencott County, Ohio).

Elizabeth D. Crangle of Wheeling West Virginia having determined to sell her interest in said farm to me by the will of my late husband Robert Crangle, deceased by selling a part of the farm to be surveyed and subdivided into lots with streets as shown on this plat. That portion of the plat including lots numbered 20, 21 and 22 has been heretofore admitted to record but as I have since it was recorded been furnished by the engineer with the courses of the various lines which were not shown on the original plat the said three lots are included in this plat and again offered for record. The street running northwesterly from James McGregor line to Lot No 17 and the street running westwardly from that street between lots 18 and 19 are fifty feet wide and are dedicated to the use of the public as such. The street between lots 19 and 20 is forty feet wide, and as such is dedicated to the use of the public together with the right of passage under the tracks of the Ohio Valley Railway Company which was reserved in the deed for right of way from Robert Crangle and wife to that Company.
