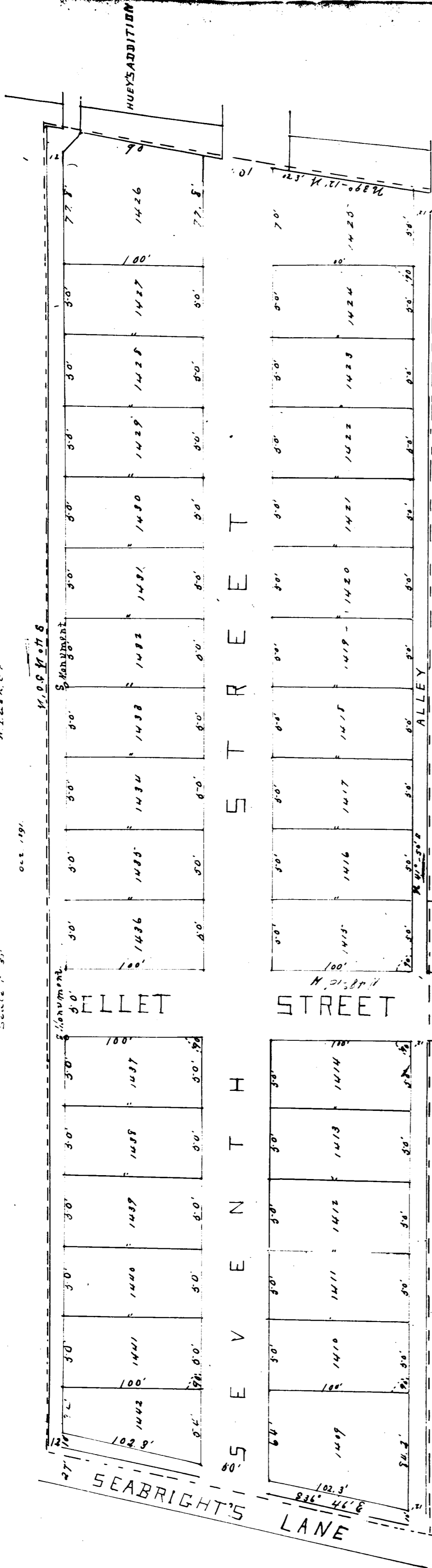


ELLET HEIR'S ADDITION TO MARTIN'S FERRY, OHIO.

R. 2 and a part of the land was owned by Jos. Baker and Chas. Bell. It by Samuel Sharpless by deed dated August 11th 1852 and recorded in Belmont County record of Deeds Vol. 26, Page 250.

The numbers dimensions of lots, names and widths of the Streets and alleys are as shown upon the map. The delineation proper is enclosed by dotted lines and covers tracts 5.70 Acres.

Two Iron Manure cuts 80 inches long by 1 inch in diameter are placed as shown upon the map four feet from lot lines.
