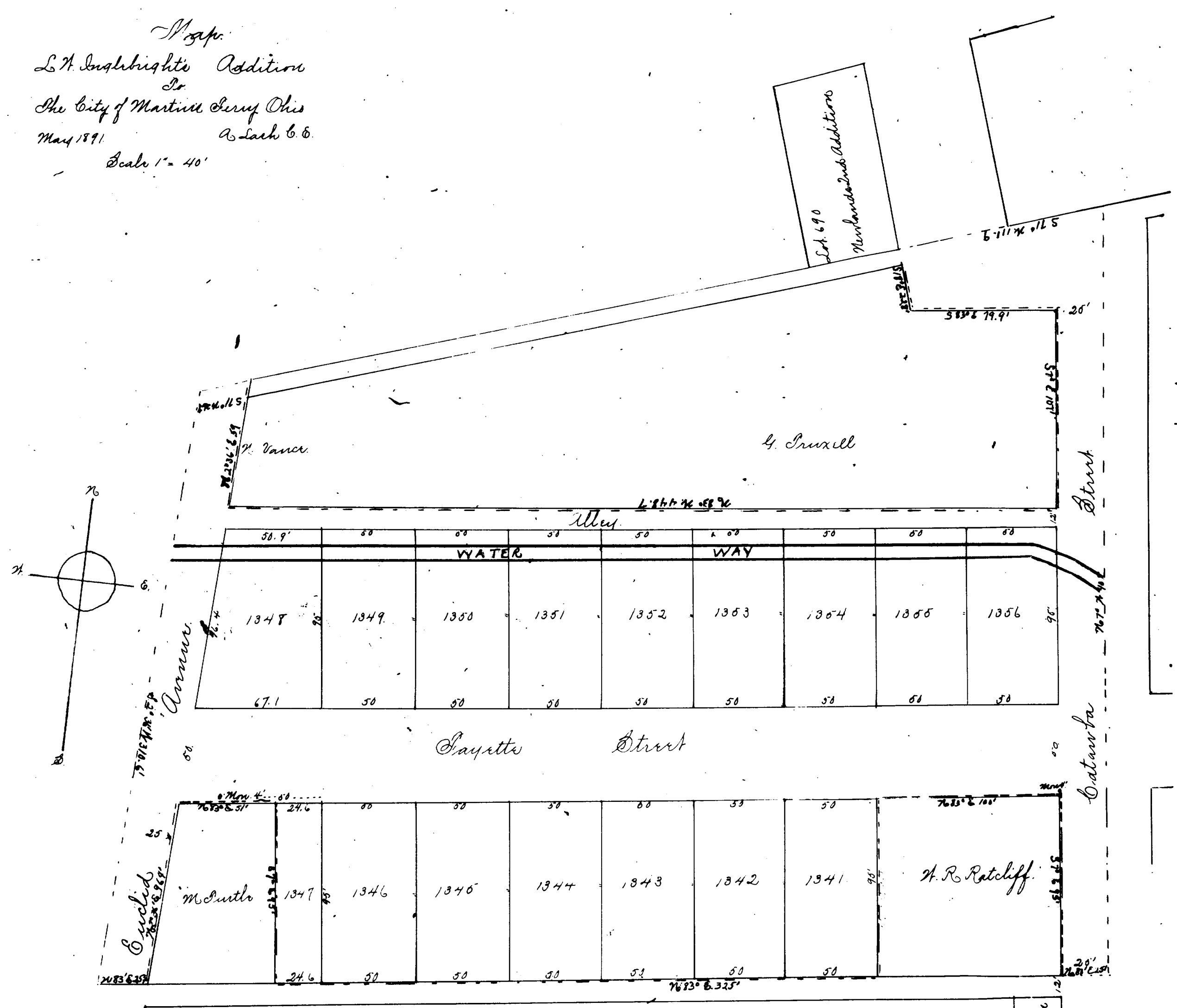


Map

I hereby certify that the within survey and map of L. H. Enghright's Addition to the City of Martins Ferry, Ohio is correct. Being located in Section 23, T. 3, R. 2 and being the same tract of land conveyed to L. H. Enghright by Cassius M. & A. D. Newland by Deed dated Oct. 23d 1876 and recorded in Belmont County Records Vol. 100 Page 142. The names and dimensions of Lots, Names and widths of streets and alleys are as shown upon the Map. The Addition proper is indeed by dotted lines and contains 2.57 Acres. Six Iron Monuments 36 inches by 24 round and planted as shown on Map 4 feet from Lot line.
