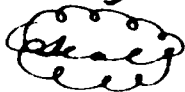


*Survey Plat and Description of Dunn's Addition*  
 To the Town of Holloway, in the S.E. quarter of Section Nine  
 and the S.W. 2<sup>d</sup> Sec. No. 3, Township 6<sup>th</sup> Range Six Plurisham, Town-  
 ship Belmont County Ohio, commenced at a Stone on the S.E.  
 Corner of Street east of lot No. 13, in Holloway and contained  
 the line of the south boundary of lots in the town of Holloway S. 89°  
 23' E. 515 ft to a stone on the S.E. Corner of lot No. 10; Thence S. 37° E.  
 100 ft. to a stone on N.E. Cor. of Lot No. 10; Thence N. 89° 23' W. 515 ft to a  
 Stone on the N.W. Corner of Lot No. 1; Thence S. 37° W. 100 ft to the beginning  
 of first block; Thence S. 37° W. 140 ft to the S.W. Corner of Lot No. 20; Thence  
 S. 89° 23' E. 515 ft to the S.E. Corner of Lot No. 11; Thence N. 37° E. 140 ft to the S.E.  
 Corner of lot No. 10 containing 2 Acres 3 Rods 13.79 Perches. All lots are  
 50 ft by 100 ft. Streets 40 ft wide, Alley 15 ft.
