

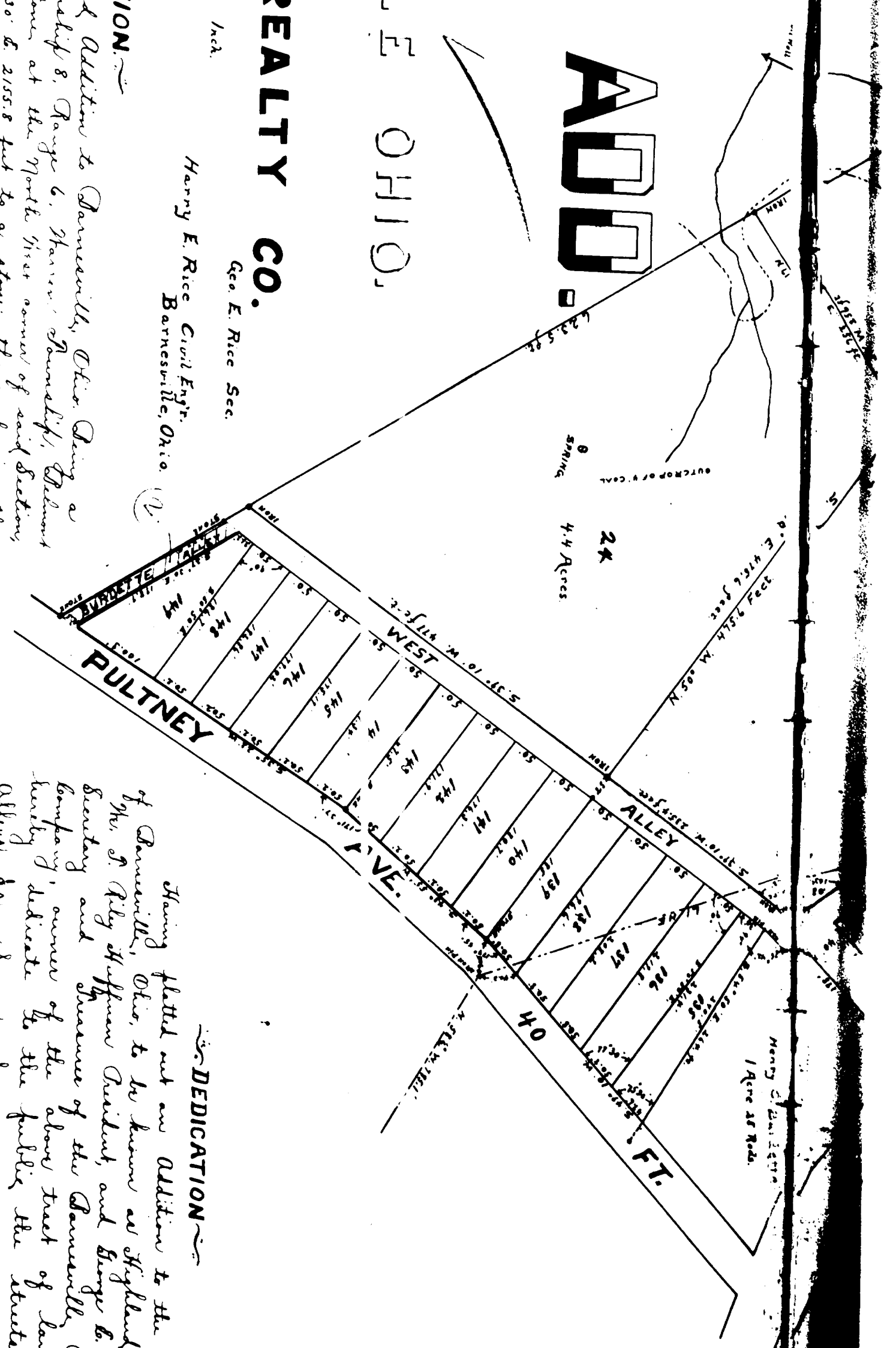

DESCRIPTION

The Barnesville, South Lawrence, Highland Addition to Barnesville, Ohio, being a part of the North West Quarter of Section 21, Township 8, Range 6, Thomsen, Standard, Adams County, Ohio. Beginning for the same at a stone at the North West corner of said Section, thence with the North line of said section S 88° 50' E 2155.8 feet to a stone, thence bearing the said Section, line S 11° 38' W 1172 feet; thence S 29° 40' W 2932 feet to a point in west 17th Street; thence N 58° 15' W 53.8 feet; thence S 49° 28' W 198 feet to an iron nail; thence S 54° 50' E 240.5 feet to an iron nail; thence S 49° 10' W 250.8 feet to a stone; thence S 45° 55' W 200.8 feet; to a stone; thence S 88° 22' W 2675 feet; to a stone; thence N 27° 30' W 2664 feet to the place of Beginning; Containing 60.94 Acres of which 23.57 Acres is in the Corporation of the Village of Barnesville, Ohio.
