ORDINANCE No. 35.

An Ordinance accepting and confirming the dedication of Streets, Avenues, Alleys and Public Ways of Thralls addition to the Village of Bethesda, Ohio.

Be it Ordained By the Council of the village of Bethesda, in the State of Ohio. Section 1. That the Streets, Avenues, Alleys and public ways of Thralls addition to the said Village of Bethesda, in the State of Ohio, as platted and surveyed by D.C. Kennon, surveyor, in April, 1913, dedicated to the public use on the 9th day of Sept. 1913, by Lincoln H. Thrall, be and the same are hereby accepted and confirmed under said dedication.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after passage and legal publication.

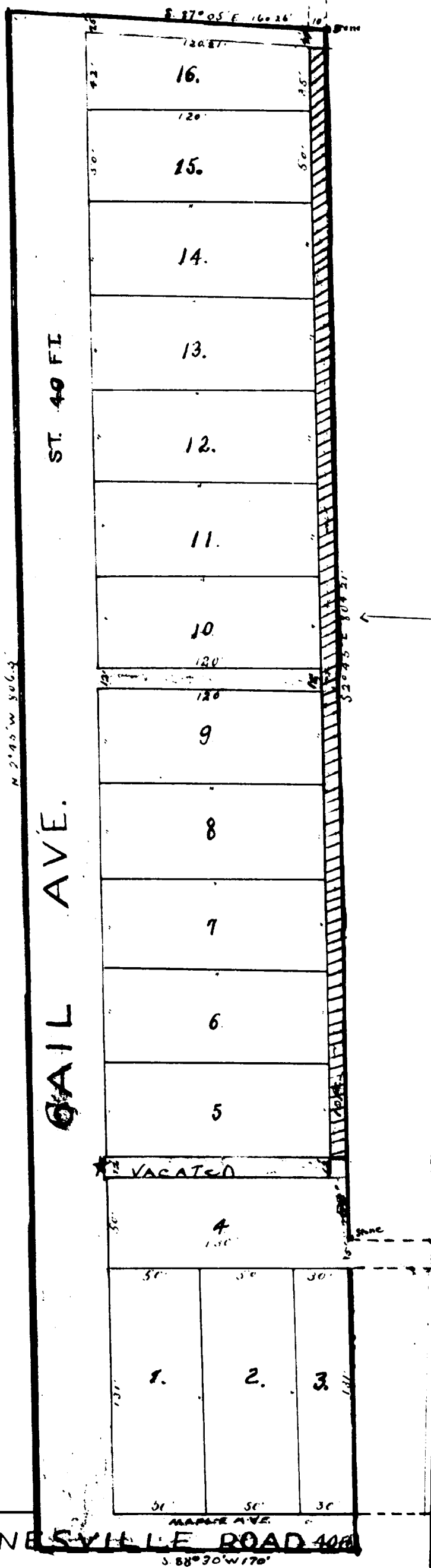
