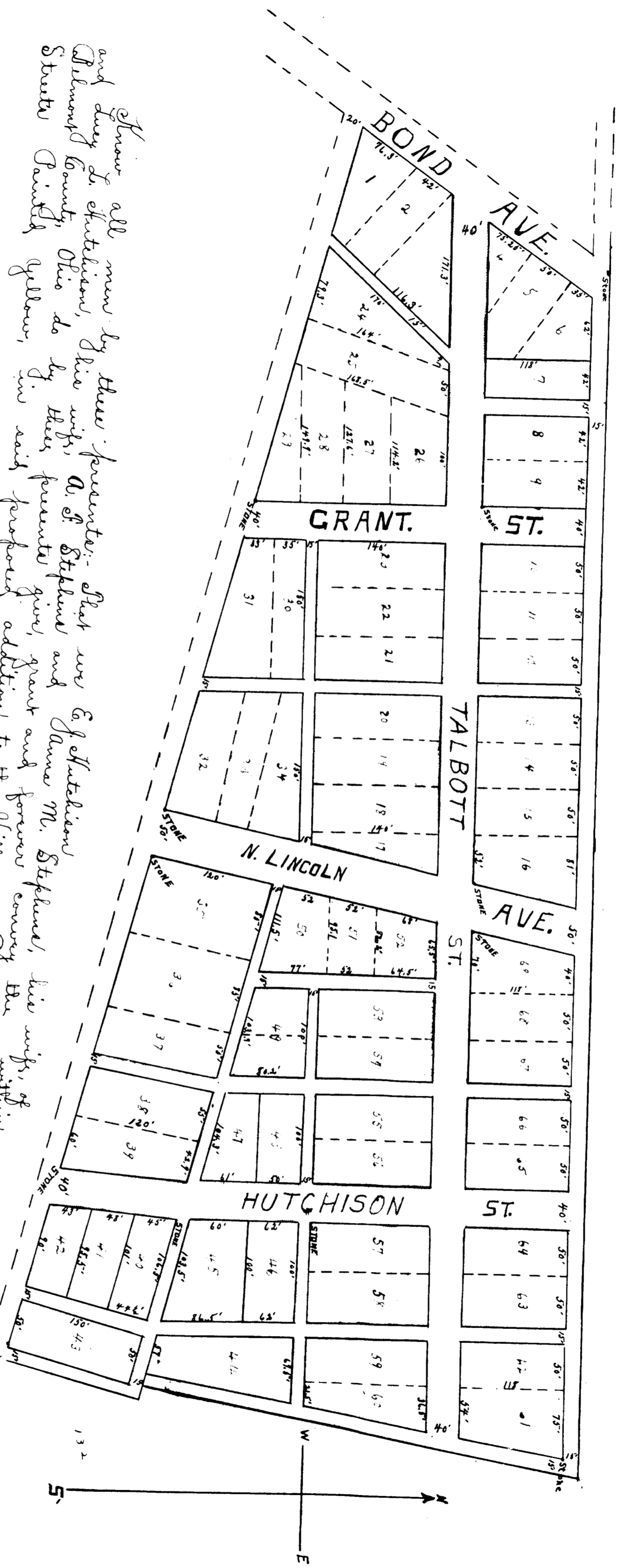


DEDICATION, TALBOTT AND HUTCHISON STREET'S BARNESVILLE, OHIO.
