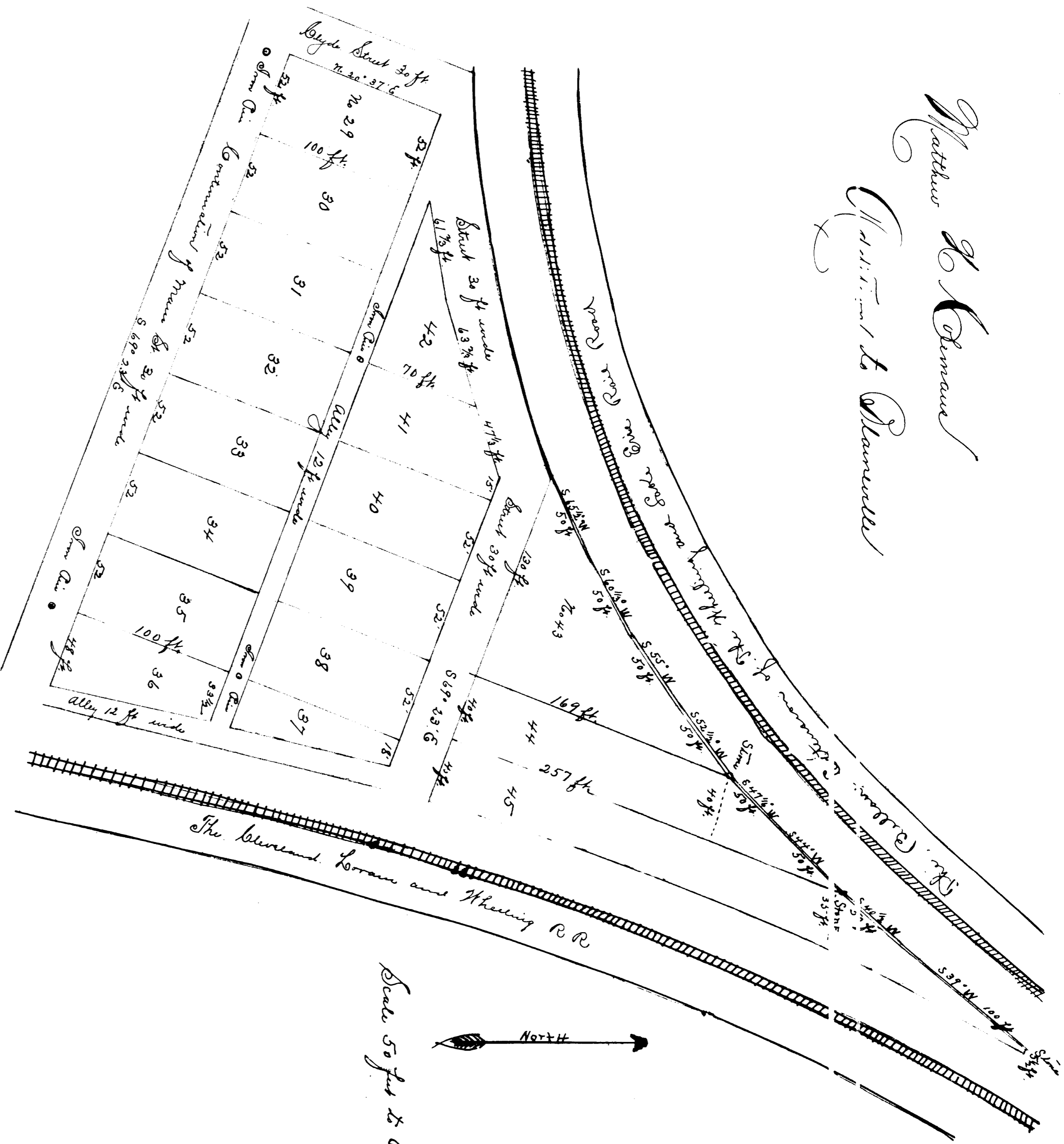


Matthew H. Coleman Petitioner to Blountville
