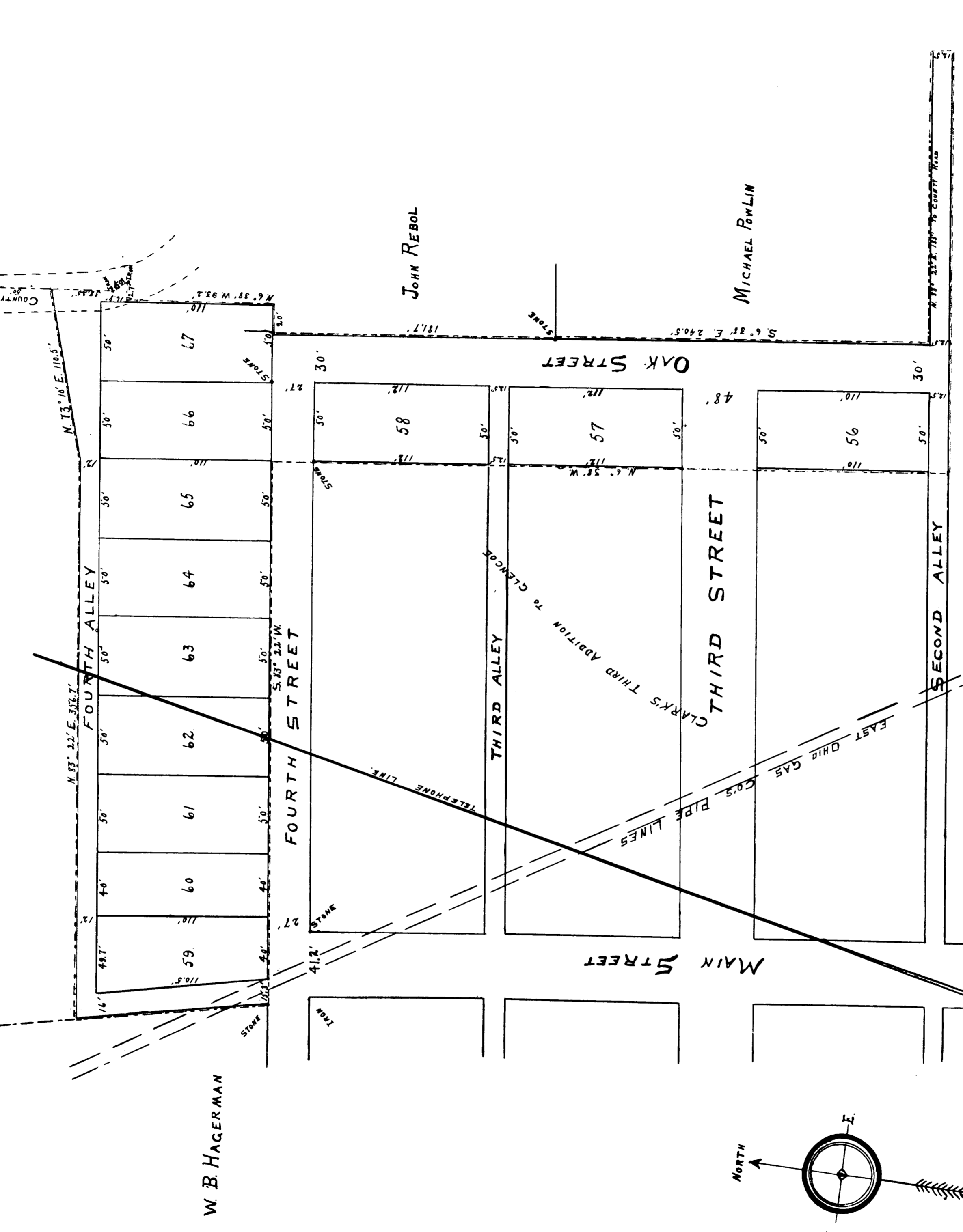


PLAT OF CLARK'S FOURTH ADDITION TO GLENCOE

SCALE: 50' = 1"

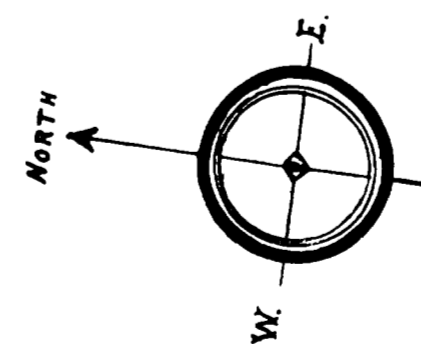

Plat of a survey made May 2^d 1905, for Dr. John A. Clark, of a tract of land, situated in the North West quarter of Section No. 35, Township No. 5 in Range No. 3, Allegheny Suburb, Belmont County, Ohio. Said tract was divided into a number of lots, streets and alleys, to be known as Clark's Fourth Addition to the Village of Glenora. The lots are numbered, the streets and alleys named and one of the lots and located as follows upon the above plat. There are planted at points as shown thereon a number of good and sufficient monuments, from which to make future measurements and surveys. I hereby certify that said lots, streets and alleys were carefully measured upon the ground and platted according to the survey, and that said tract as shown within the red dotted boundary lines contains 2.773 acres. Excepting therefrom the area of emptying alley, which has been transferred, as per plat Clark's Third Addition to Glenora, there is to be transferred by this Addition 1.773 acres.

Whereas all monuments set by the said M. Powell and J. A. Clark, in and about the above plat of Clark's Fourth Addition to Glenora, Ohio, are hereby dedicated to public use, and the streets and alleys shown thereon within the red dotted boundary lines, and also by this, our temporary survey shown upon the plan of Clark's Fourth Addition to Glenora, are hereby dedicated to public use, and the surveying lines and angles shown thereon are hereby dedicated to said Clark's Fourth Addition to Glenora, Ohio, and also by this, John Corbille, deceased, by deed bearing date April 5th 1899 and recorded in Belmont County Records of Deeds Volume 47, page 472 in accordance with which deed the lower of six foot view of each is hereby reserved. Said tract is also subject to the rights of the East Ohio Gas Co. recorded in Volume 122 page 149 records of Deeds of said County, and also rights of the Central District and Printing Lithograph Co. recorded in records of Deeds of said County, Vol. 22, page 35. Witness our signatures, hereto this 14th day of June A. D. 1905.
