

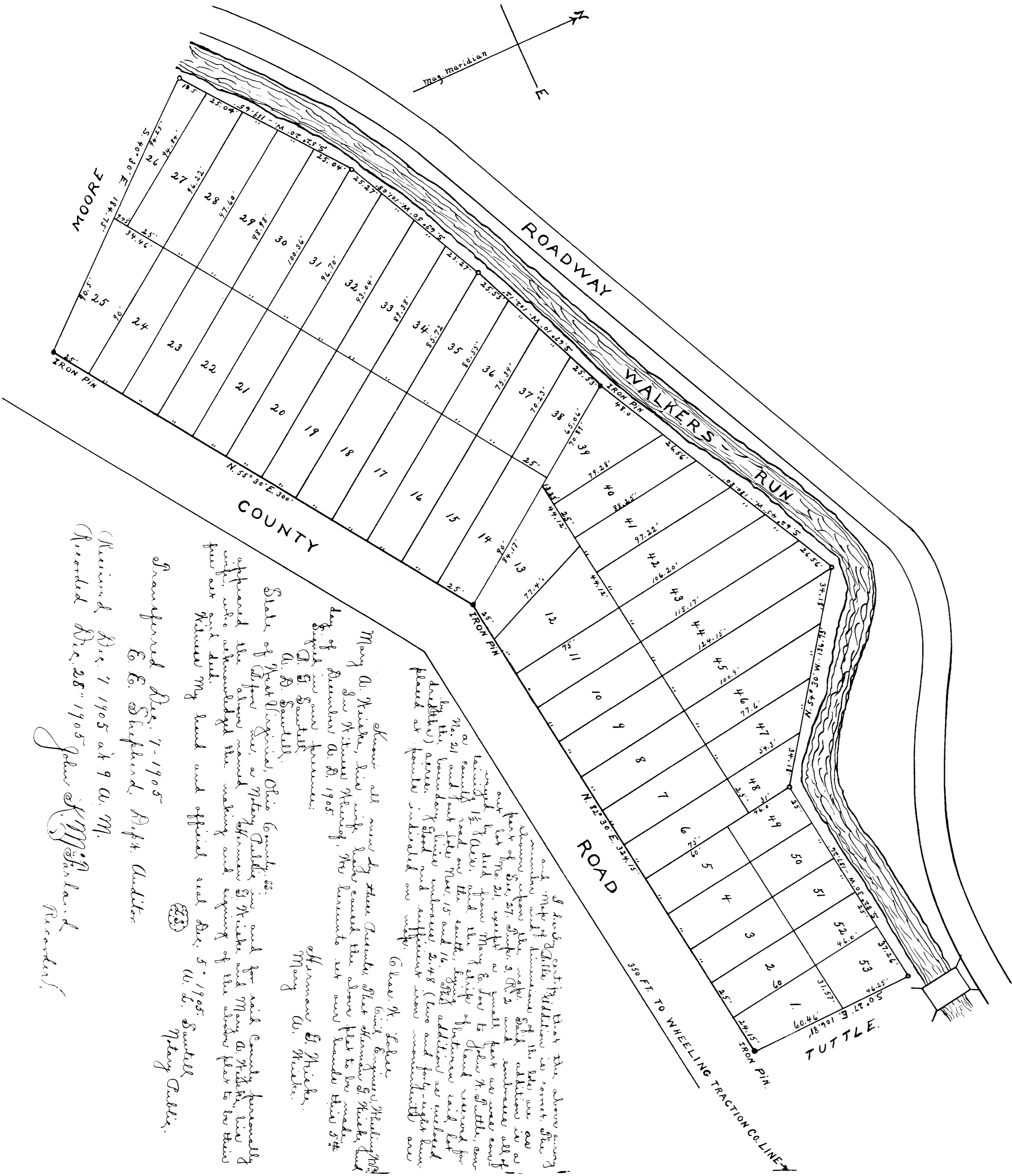
BELL'S ADDITION 70 WEST WHEELING

Said addition is a part of Site 27, Site 3, Site 2 and additions all of our lot No. 21, except a small part as was conveyed by deed from Mary & Joe Tuttle, our heirs, to John N. Tuttle, our son, by deed, signed by John N. Tuttle, our son, by the boundary lines 15 and 16, Site 1 addition as recorded in the deed (see 2:48) (two and forty-eight hundred and sufficient more monuments) are placed at points indicated on map. 6 lines N. 30° E.
