Being proposed changes in said M^{rs} Farland's Second Addition to St. Clairsville, O. Said changes are made by abandoning West Street as shown upon the Plat of M^{rs} Farland's Second Addition to St. Clairsville, recorded in Belmont County Records of Plate Volume 5 Page 10. changing the position and dimensions of lots Nos. 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39 and 40, and changing Spring Alley, sixteen feet wide, to Union Street, forty feet wide.

There are planted at points as shown thereon a number of good and sufficient monuments from which to make future measurements and surveys.
