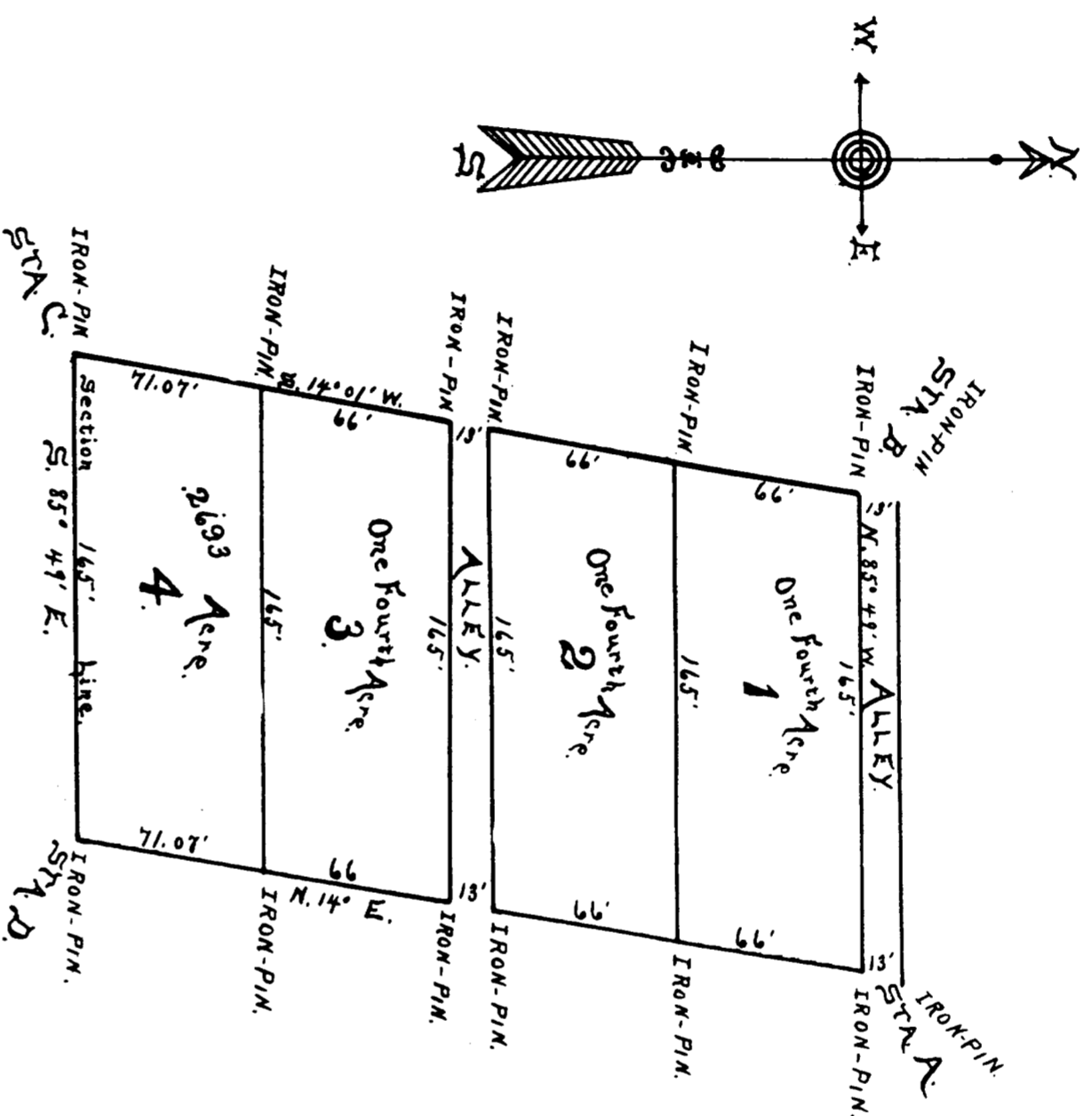

Description:

Situate in the S. 1/4 Cr. No. 30, of Sec. No. 8, T. 8, R. 4, beginning at an iron pin on the N. 1/4 corner of Lot No. 5 in Gossett's Addition to the Village of Bannock O. Shaver, N. 85° 49' 1/2 W. 165 feet to Sta. D. Shaver S. 14° 00' 1/2 W. 283.07 feet to Sta. E. Shaver S. 88° 49' E. 165 feet to Sta. F. Shaver N. 14° 01' E. 283.07 feet to Sta. A. The beginning containing 1.117 acres.

This Addition is situate directly west of Gossett's Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, each contain one-fourth acre.

Lot No. 4, contains .2693 acres. Each lot corner is marked with an iron pin.
