

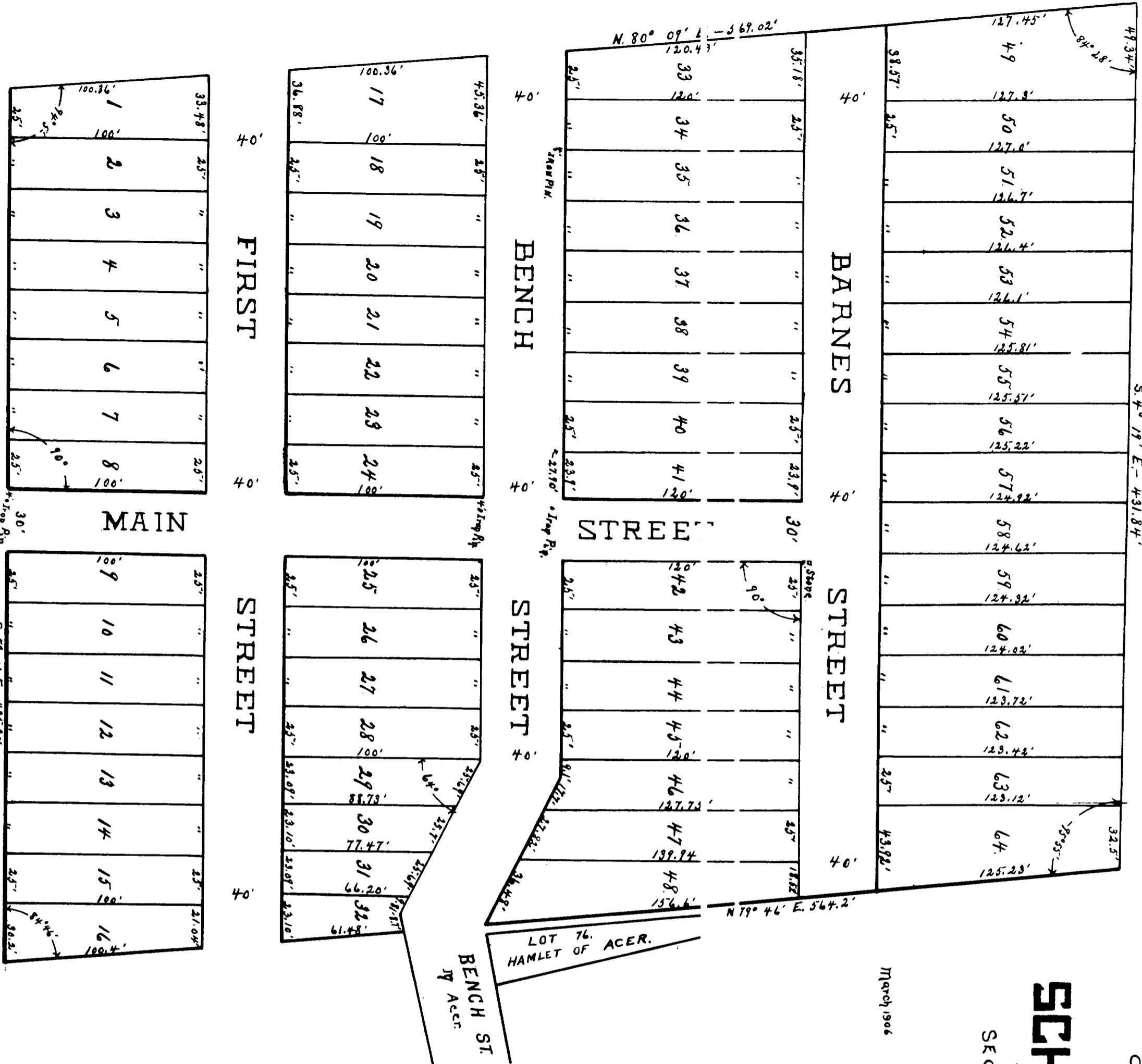
CHANGE MAP OF

I hereby certify that the within changed Survey and Map of six owners of Schaper Place, do correct and include in Section No. 34, Tp. No. 3 and R. No. 21 and tract No. 4, as conveyed to John Schaper by A. S. Schaper, by deed dated July 14th A. D. 1875, and recorded in Belmont County record of deeds in Vol. 110, page 435, accepting 2 1/2 acres off the north side thereof. The number and dimensions of the lots, names and widths of Streets are as shown upon the Map, there being no public ground public lot or Out lots, a good and sufficient good line is marked by six inches on top, and three feet long is planted at the North East corner of lot No. 42. Four feet at right angles to the lot line, as shown upon the Map for a corner from which to make future surveys also four iron pins, sixty inches long by one inch diameter are planted in every case four feet at right angles to the lot lines, as shown upon the Map.
