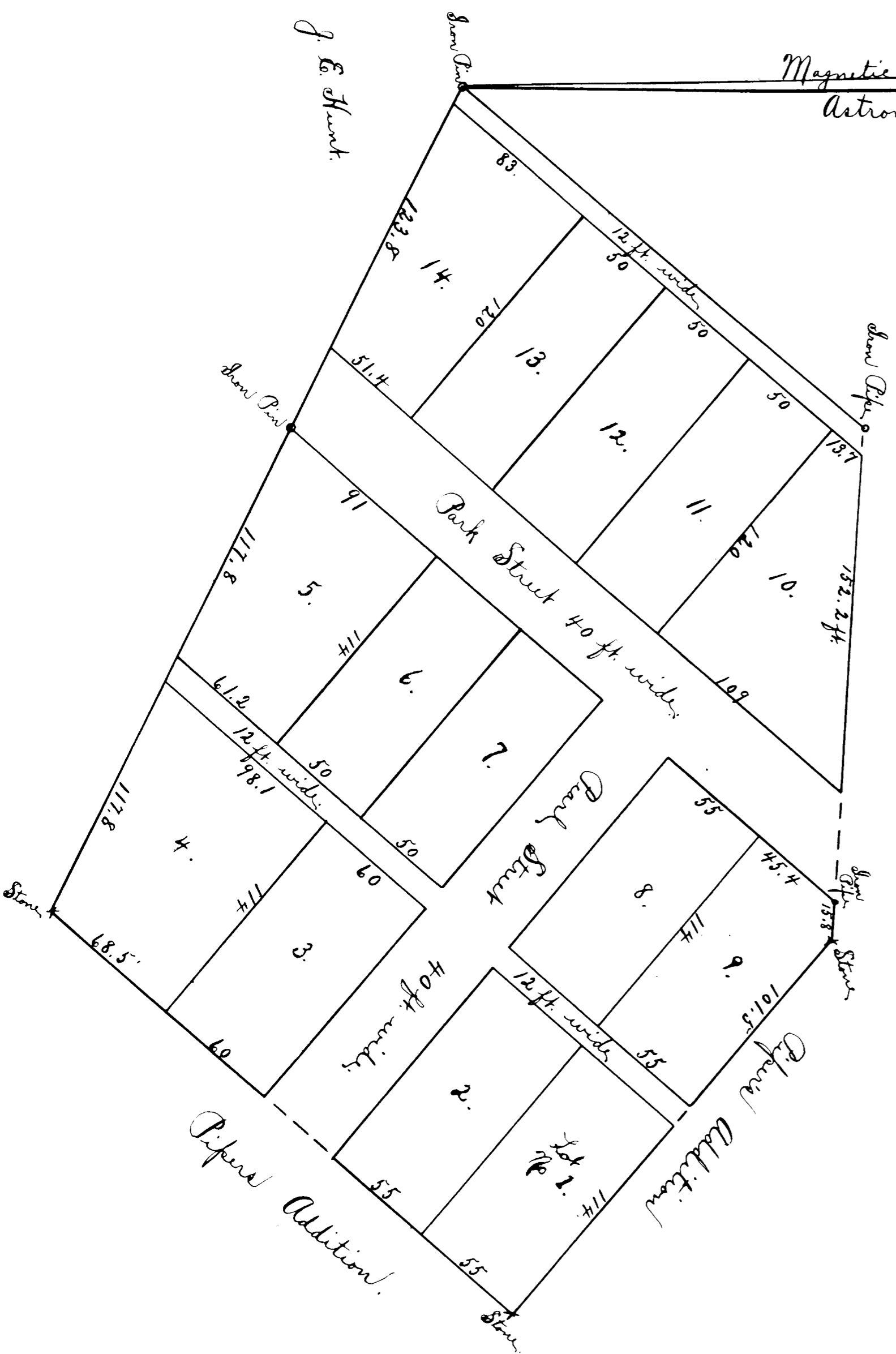

A part of the West Division of Section 23, Township 7, Range 5: Beginning for the same at a stone at the South West corner of Pipkin's Addition and running North 64 1/2° West 425.5 ft. to an iron pin; thence North 40 1/2° East 240.5 ft. to an iron pin in the South line of O'Neal's Second Addition; thence South 87 1/2° East 234 ft. to a stone; thence South 49 1/2° East 227.5 ft. to a stone; thence South 40 1/2° West 278.5 ft. to the place of beginning; containing two and eighty four hundredths 42.84 Acres.
