ORDINANCE NO. 6337

AN ORDINANCE VACATING PENN STREET AND AN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF MARTINS FERRY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on June 19, 1973, a Petition was filed to vacate Penn Street and an alley as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, all the owners of the property abutting the part of the street and alley proposed to be vacated have filed herein their written consents to such vacation according and pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, this council is satisfied that there is good cause for vacating said street and alley as hereinafter described and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTINS FERRY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I. That Penn Street between the east line of Second Street and the west line of First Street and the alley between Penn Street and Lombard Street from the east line of Second Street and the west line of First Street as indicated on the map attached to the Petition, which Petition and map are on file in the office of the Clerk of the Council in a file bearing the same number as this ordinance, is hereby vacated.

SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Martins Ferry, Ohio, and for the further reason that the lots owned by the petitioners, and the street and alley to be vacated, are immediately needed for sale for industrial expansion.

SECTION III. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

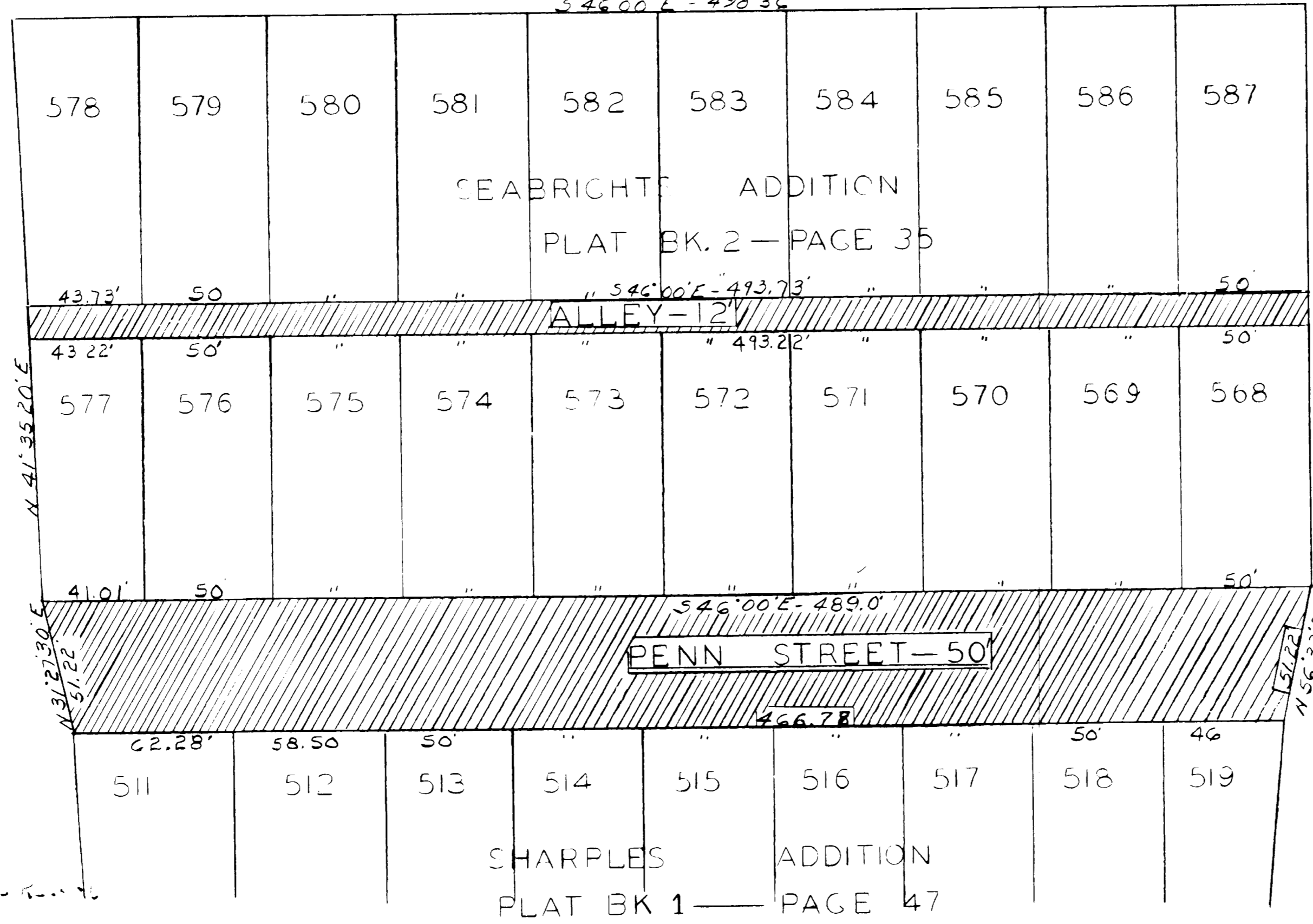
