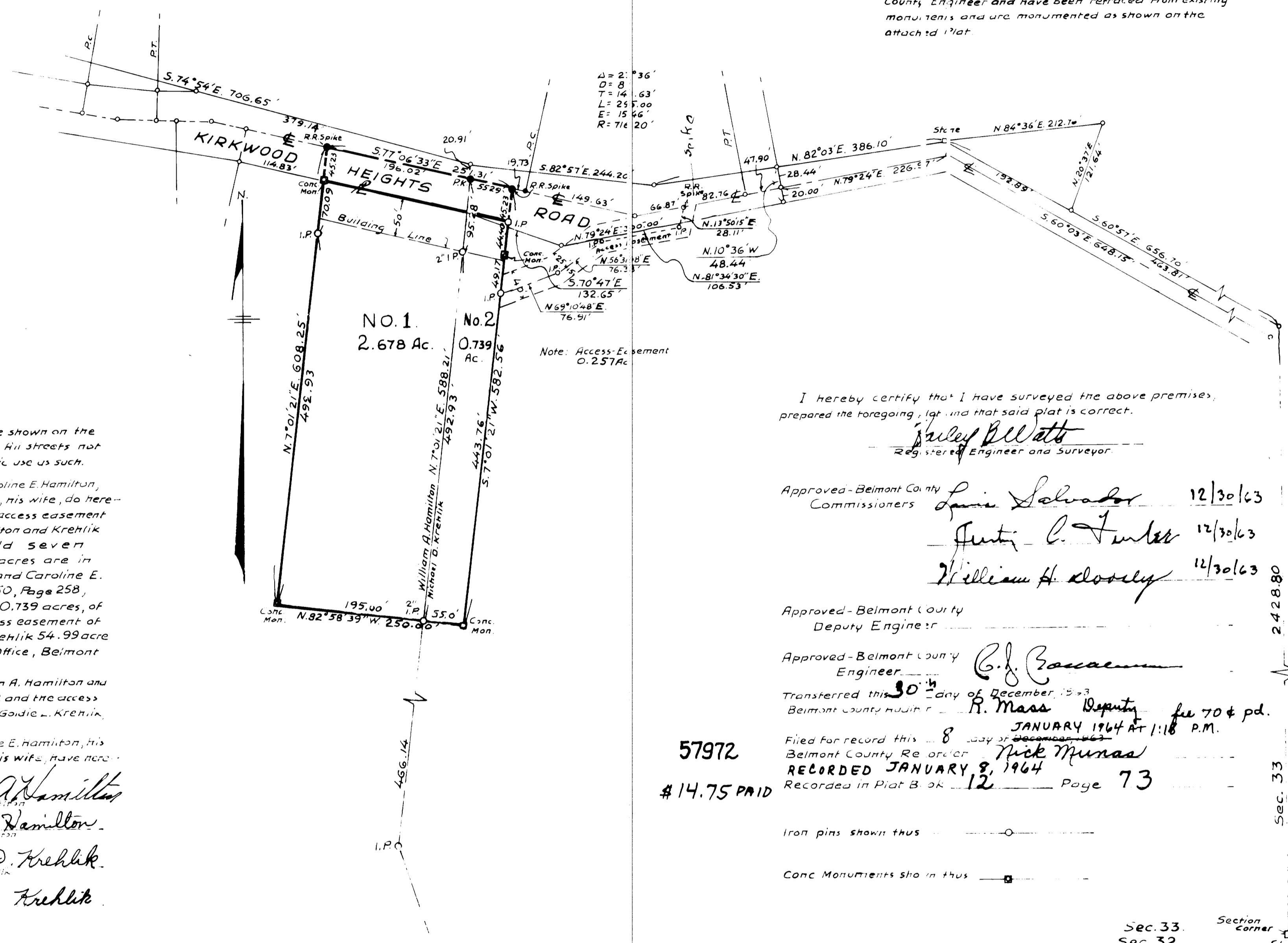


HAMILTON and KREHLIK SUBDIVISION.
