ORDINANCE No. 267

DESCRIPTION

Situated in The Township of Union, County of Belmont and State of Ohio and being a part of the northeast quarter of Section 20, Township 8 and Range 5 (this tract also now being in The Village of Morristown)
Beginning for a description of the tract at a concrete monument on the east line of said section 20 which is also the present corporation line, said monument bears N 4°17' E 2364.26 ft. from an old marked stone at the southeast corner of said northeast quarter section.
Thence from the place of beginning and following along the section line N 4°17' E 193.01 feet to an iron pin, thence continuing on the same line N 4°17' E 31.39 feet to an iron pin at the south edge of the present concrete paving of State Route No. 40, thence S 73°08' W 132.17 feet to an iron pin at the south edge of said paving, thence leaving the road and passing through a partition wall between a garage and lubrication room S 15°22' E 205.80 feet to a concrete monument and passing an iron pin on the state right of way line at 29.28 feet, thence N 76°41' E 57.32 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.454 of an acre subject to all legal highways and any other easements previously granted.
