

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1403

VACATING ALLEY BETWEEN LOTS NUMBERED 629 AND 630 IN THE VILLAGE OF BRIDGEPORT, OHIO

WHEREAS on the 21st day of June, 1965, a petition by persons owning lots numbered 629 and 630, being the lots abutting the alley whose vacation is sought, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley be vacated in its entirety; and

WHEREAS all of the owners abutting said alley have consented in writing to said vacation thus obviating the necessity for newspaper publication as provided by Section 723.07 R.C.; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, Now Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIDGEPORT, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the alley situated between lots numbered 629 and 630 as the same are shown and designated on the Plat of the Village of Bridgeport, said alley being twelve feet in width and one hundred twenty-nine feet in length, more or less, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of June, 1965, a petition by persons owning lots numbered 631 and 632, being the lots abutting the alley whose vacation is sought, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley be vacated in its entirety; and

WHEREAS, all of the owners abutting said alley have consented in writing to said vacation thus obviating the necessity for newspaper publication as provided by Section 723.07 R.C.; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, Now Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIDGEPORT, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the alley situated between lots numbered 631 and 632 as the same are shown and designated on the Plat of the Village of Bridgeport, said alley being twelve feet in width and one hundred twenty-nine feet in length, more or less, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

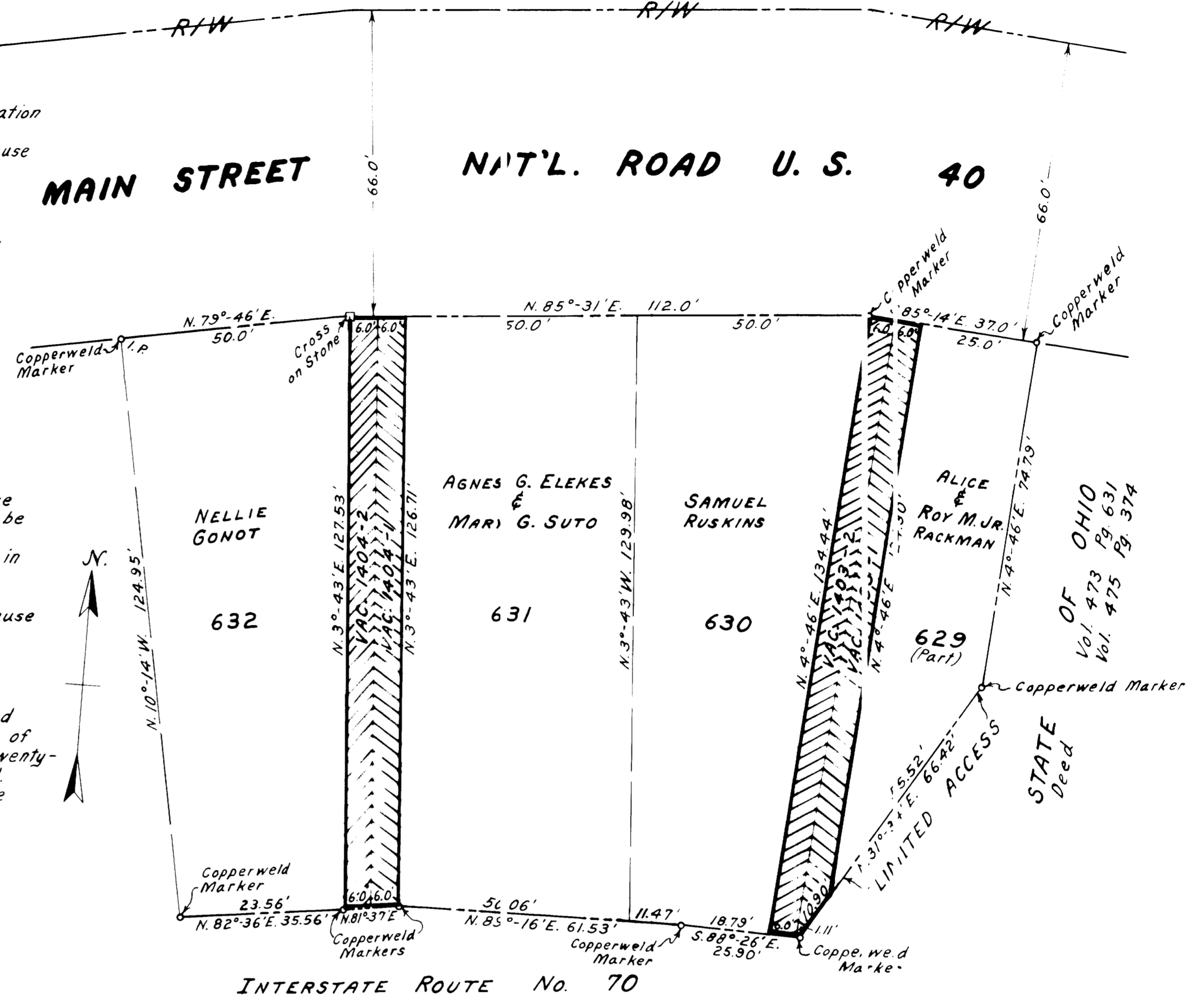
