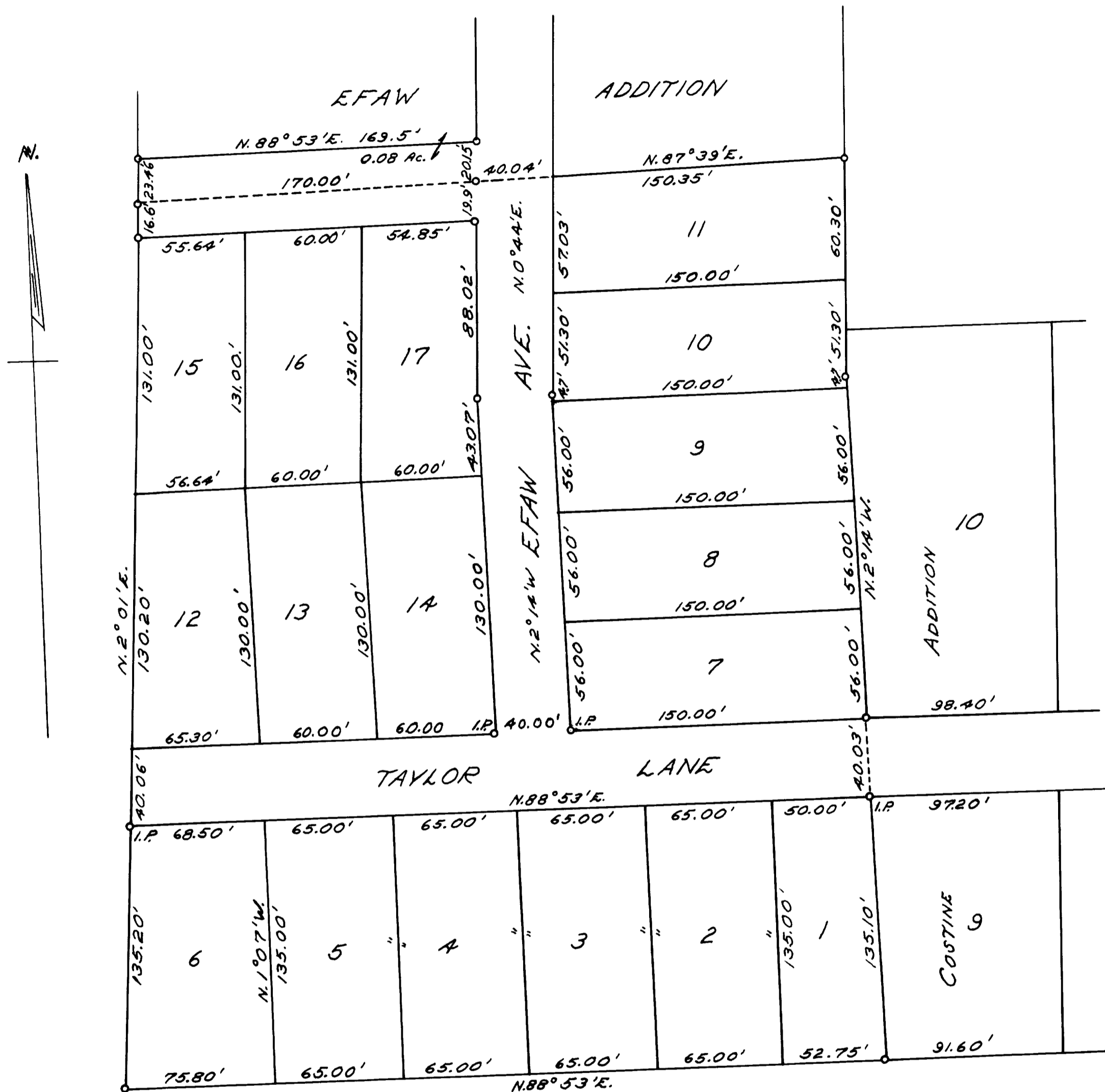


# PLAT OF TAYLORS ADDITION
